GLCACS is a local chapter of Chinese American Chemical Society (CACS) in the Great Lakes region, including Illinois, Indiana, Wisconsin, Michigan, Minnesota, Iowa, and Ohio. CACS is a Chinese-American professional organization affiliated with both the American Institute of Chemical Engineers (AIChE) and the American Chemical Society (ACS). Since its founding, GLCACS has played an active role in promoting professional development and networking for GLCACS members and non-members alike.

Each year, GLCACS invites students, postdoctoral fellows, and researchers from all regional universities to participate in the Poster Contest and Awards session during the Annual Meeting. Regardless of academic disciplines and ethnic origins, all graduate students and postdoctoral fellows are encouraged to participate in the contest.

Guideline for Poster Preparation

1. Each poster author will be provided with a space of 5ft W x 4ft H. Please do not exceed these dimensions.
2. The space shall be indicated with the poster number in its upper right or left corner, which will be used as identification in the award ballot.
3. Each poster paper must have a title in large font. Materials will normally be read by attendees from a distance of 3 feet or more, so lettering on illustrations should be large and legible.
4. Suggestion: text on panel should be between 16 and 22 pt to be legible. Framing the text by putting a box around it will also help readers to focus.
5. Make sure your presentation flows in a logical sequence. It should have an introduction, body and conclusion.
6. GLCACS will provide push pins, marking pens, etc
7. Authors are responsible to mount their own posters after registration. GLCACS staff will provide any help that is needed. Poster mounting should be completed prior to the start of the conference at 9:00AM if the authors do not want to miss any of the conference presentation.
8. If any authors want their posters back, they are responsible for removing them after the session of student poster award (5:30 PM).

Guideline for Poster Presentations:

- Each presentation should be done by **power point**.
- An author of each poster has **2 minutes only** to give an oral presentation about your poster (give a brief but attractive short talk about your interesting research to attract people to see your poster and vote for you!).
- You will be disqualified from the competition award if the two-minute limit is not adhered to.
- The presentation order will be decided based on alphabetical order at the registration desk on May 4th (Sat).
- GLCACS will provide a Projector and Laptop. Please send your presentation (.ppt file) through email to glcacsposter@gmail.com by 5:00 PM, April 29th, 2013.
